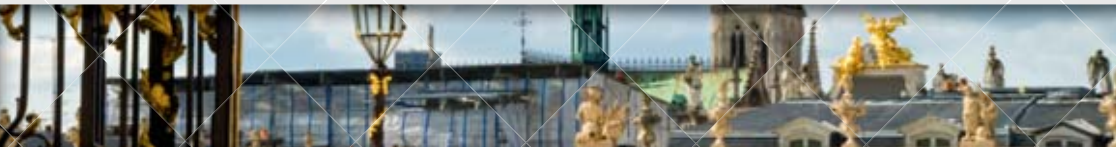

2nd World AVM Congress: A Congress focused on Brain AVMs for Neurologists, Neurosurgeons, Radiotherapists and Interventional Neuroradiologists.

Brain arterio venous malformations are highly complex vascular lesions that may have devastating consequences, and that require often multidisciplinary approaches and decisions.

Knowledge on physiopathology, biology, or natural history of these diseases are still in progress or controversial, even if considerable advancements have been achieved over the past decade, allowing improved managements of the patients.

The aim of the 2nd World AVM meeting is to focus on the latest information available about arteriovenous malformations of the brain.
